The *Sultana* was a sidewheel Mississippi steamboat carrying

almost two thousand recently-released Union prisoners-of-war back north at the end of the Civil War. At 2:00 a.m. on April 27, 1865, when the boat was seven miles above Memphis, her boilers exploded. Almost 1,200 people perished in the worst maritime disaster in United States history. By bringing his research back to primary sources, Salecker dispels myths and adds to the story of the *Sultana*.
